

System Guide Documentation Checklist Coordinated Entry System (CES)

Required Documents for Project Enrollment

- Brighter Days
 Documentation
 Worksheet
- Documented Proof of Homelessness completed by the intake worker

Children (*If available*-for YYA Families)

- Birth Certificate or
- Proof of Guradianship

YYA

18+ (if available)

- Valid Gov't issued ID
- Social Security Card

Break Down of Required Documentation

- Homeless Certification- Proof of Homelessness which can be in the form of either a:
 - o Brighter Days Youth Self-Certification of Homelessness (Category 1,2 and 4)
 - System Guide Direct Observation (Cat. 1)
 - System Guide Direct Observation (Cat. 2)
 - O HMIS records (shelter entries, BH entries, service transactions, case notes)
 - Third Party Written Verification
 - Category 4 Self Attestation
- **ROI**-_This document grants permission for information to be entered into HMIS and shared with partner agencies. *This is required for all adults 18+.*

Additional Documentation for Housing

- Valid ID- Any government issued ID that's not expired (Driver's License, ID, Passport, Military ID)
- **Social Security** Social security card or receipt of social security application.
- Proof of Guardianship_ While birth certificated is ideal If the child/children birth certificate
 cannot be easily obtained one of the following can be used as an alternative. It must have both
 the adult's name and child name on the document:
 - SNAP Letter (Food Stamps or TANF)
 - Shot Record
 - SSI/SSDI Award Letter
 - School Record
 - Current Court Documents demonstrating custodial or guardian relationship
- Proof of Pregnancy: This is required if there are no other children in the home. This can be:
 - Signed letter from doctor on letter head with due date
 - Medicaid/WIC Acceptance Letter for unborn
